I. Continuation of CSB #97 discussion (John Riemer)

LCRI	Comments
1.7B23	Multiparts now can have "Description based on" note
2.5B9	LC practice: If unnumbered plates are significant, they may be mentioned Discussion: Some situations where they would be considered significant: plates that appear in a biography; maps
2.5B16	This practice is not new
2.5B17	LC counts all volumes, not just numbered volumes
2.5B21	[this was just renumbered, not changed]
2.5B23	LC considered it would be overkill to have both a GMD of "Large print" and a physical description "v. (large print)." So, LC will only use "Large print" in 300.
3.3B1	If no scale is stated, don't estimate one based on comparable maps
3.5C3	For photomechanical reproductions, give "photocopy" or the generic name of the process (e.g., blueprint) in the physical description
3.5D3	For models, give height, width, and depth in the physical description.
9.7B	URL no longer active: 856 41 \$z Electronic address (http://www...) not available when search on [date] "If a 2 nd ed. goes away when a 3 rd ed. is available, make a new record"
12.0	The rules for serials govern series. Separate records are generally made if you can have separate check-in records
12.0B1	E-serials that change title & rename all issues under the current title should be re-described using integrating entry conventions
12.0B2	For direct access serials, prefer the physical carrier as the chief source
12.1B2	When the chief source has the title in both a full form and an initialism, choose the full form as the title proper
12.1B4	For e-resources, be careful about phrases that might be considered "common titles" (as in Common title. \$p Part title)
12.1B7	If numbering occurs at the end of the title without linking words, do not use mark of omission
12.1E1	Elevated to a full rule; removed as RI
12.2B3	Do not transcribe parallel edition statements
12.1F1	Note that 21.29G interposes "21.29G...Do not apply this rule" in the middle of the RI for 21.3B. <i>Cataloger's Desktop</i> does not have this error
12.3A1	Do not use area 3 for IRs (i.e., do not use 362 0), since updates don't remain discrete.
12.3B1	May use forward slash for single issues with combined numbers (no. 1-2 → no. 1/2)
12.3C1	May use forward slash for single issues with range of chronology (1999-2000 → 1999/2000)
12.3D1	If the first issue lacks numbering and if an inferred chronological designation makes sense, use one.
12.3G1	Do not create a new record for numbering changes.
12.4D2	If the main entry includes the name of the publisher and that publisher changes, create a new record
12.5D2	Record differences in size by a range, e.g., 21-23 cm.
12.6B1	For integrating resources, if the series name is dropped, move the name from a 4XX to a 500 note. Continue to use an 8XX series entry.
12.7A2	Integrating resources: If the title changes, move the former title proper to 247. List multiple 247s in chronological order. Following rule 1.0E1, give notes in English. For serials, either transcribe designations in language of source or translate to English. For IRs, transcribe designations in

	language of source.
12.7B1	Note the frequency if known, even if evident from the title. For IRs, use the word “updated” or “updates”
12.7B4.1	Use the 247 field only for former titles proper. For other former titles, use a 246 with \$i to describe the situation
12.7B4.2	More about e-serials that don’t retain earlier title.
12.7B5.2	If a parallel title (246 11) is dropped, change the 246 11 to 246 1_ \$i Parallel title <date vie wed>: \$a 246 1_ \$i Parallel title in HTML header: \$a ... [Where chief source was HTML header]
12.7B7.1	If a phrase at head of title does not represent statement of responsibility, then use “at head of title” note.
12.7B8	Special rules for constructing linking notes for translations and legal works entered under uniform title. Use of other title information in linking note when title is solely the name of a corporate body
12.7B8	Options: Do not include date of change in linking note except in the case of absorptions.
12.7B18	Generally, LC does not create summary notes for serials
12.8B1	For IRs with ISSN and ISBNs, record both
