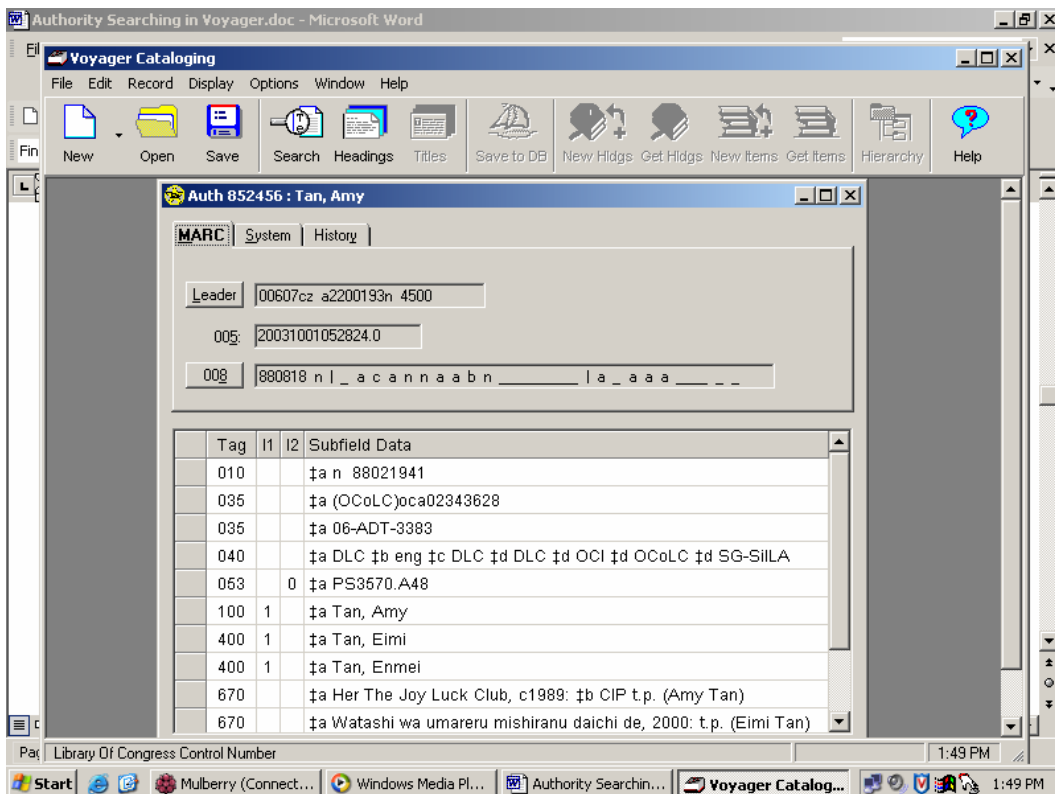
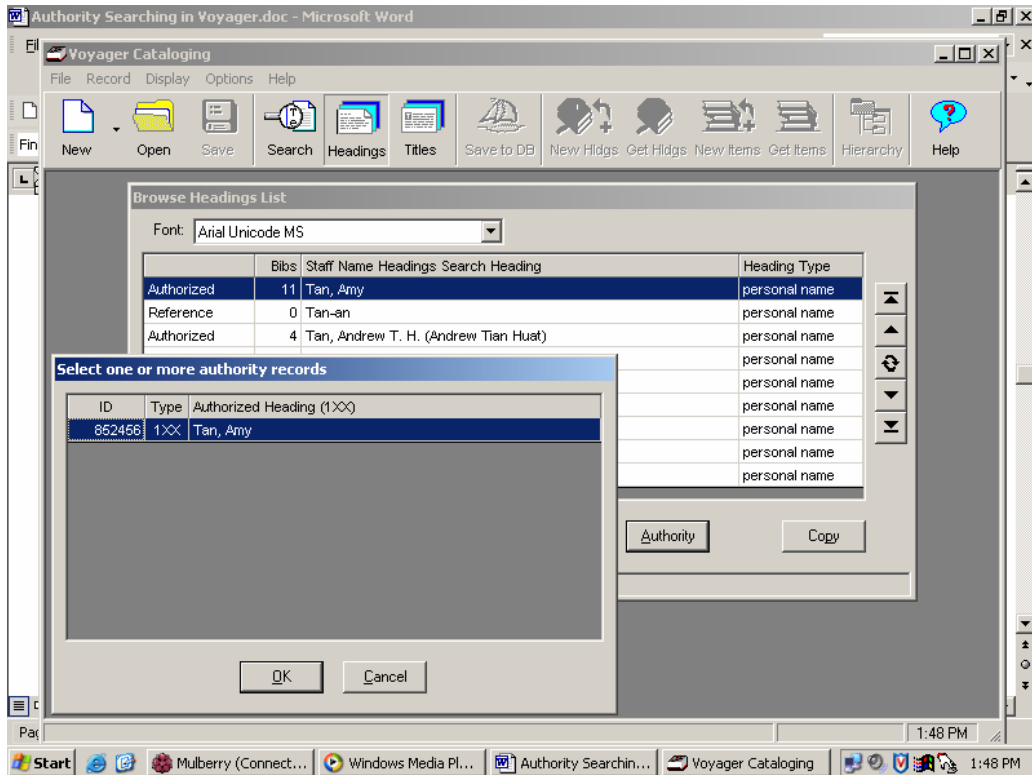
Searching for an authority record

- Index selection
- Browse OR Keyword
- Any search beginning with “Staff”



Calling up the authority record

- Highlight the desired heading (left click once)
- Click on “Authority”
- Click on “OK” in resulting window



Calling up the authority record

- Highlight the desired heading (left click once)
- Click on “Authority”
- Click on “Retrieve”
- Click on “OK”

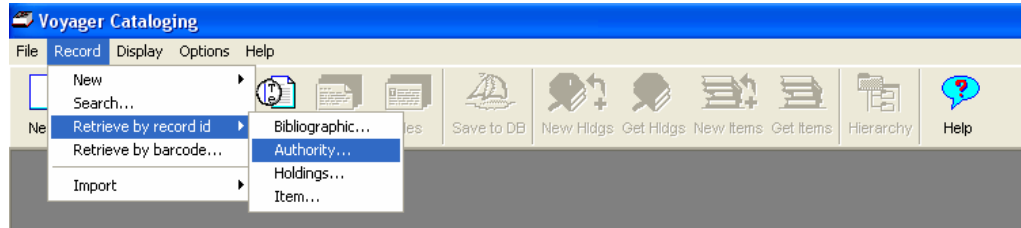

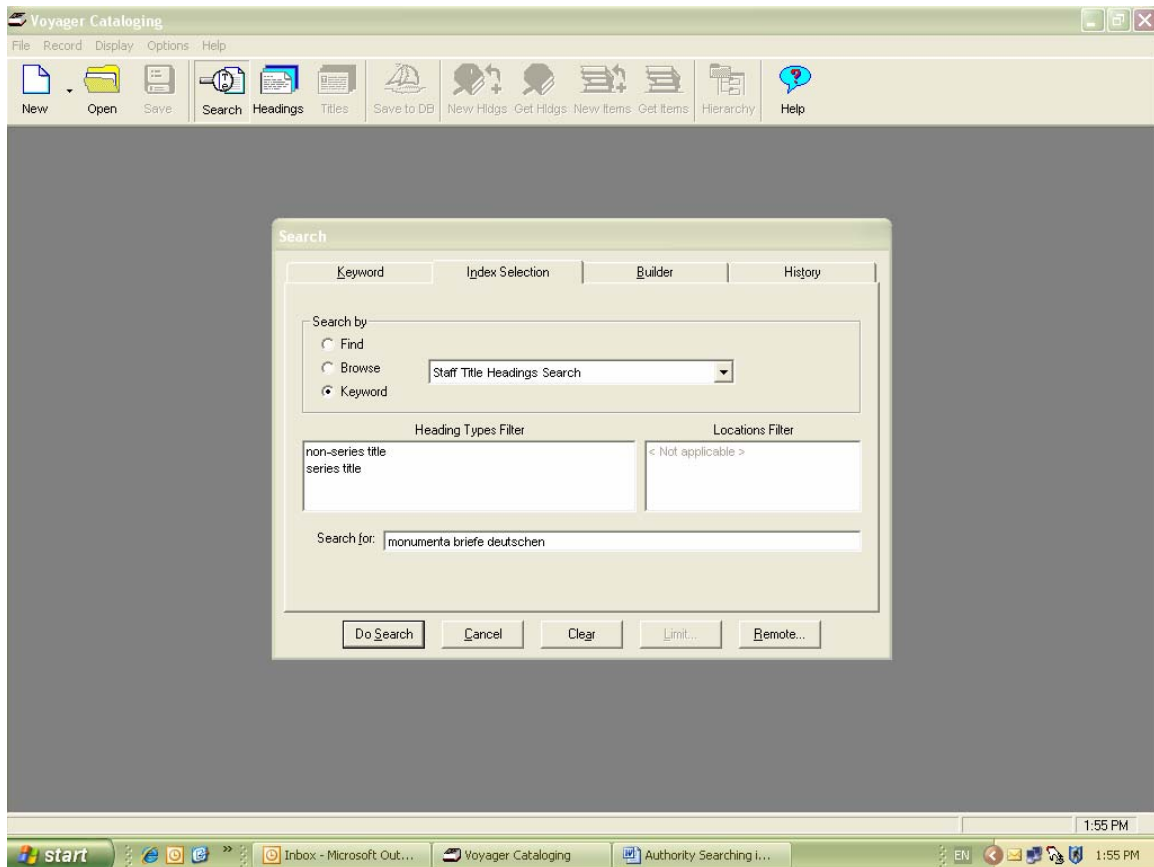

SEARCHING FOR SERIES

- Index selection
- Browse OR Keyword
- Staff Title Headings Search
- If desired, **can filter by Non-series title** (for uniform titles) **or Series title**



Resulting display:

- If no filter was chosen, display results in duplicate headings list
- First headings is for non-series title (130 in authority record; 130, 730 in bibliographic records)
- Second heading is for series headings in bibliographic records (440, 830)
- Calling up the authority record associated with either heading calls up the same exact authority record (i.e., there is only one authority record, not two as implied)

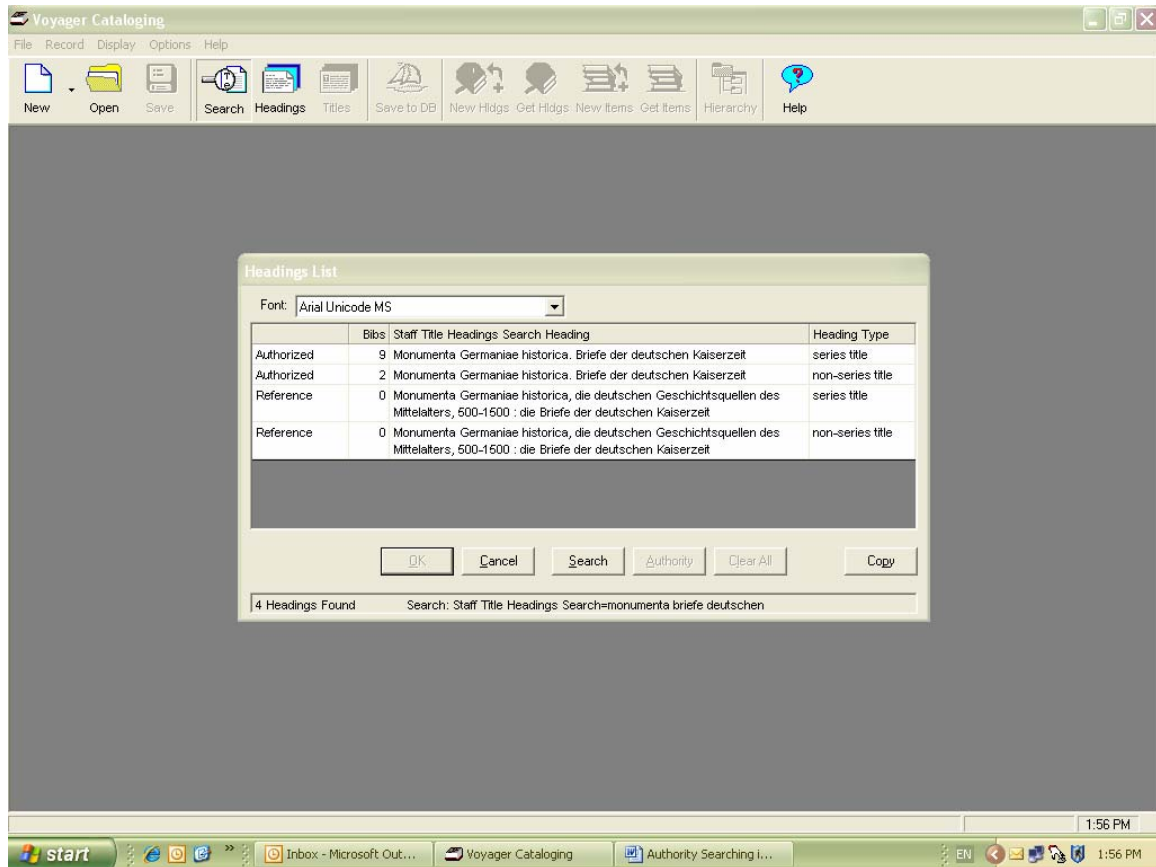


Image below:

- Second column represents second heading (screen print above); 830 in bibliographic record

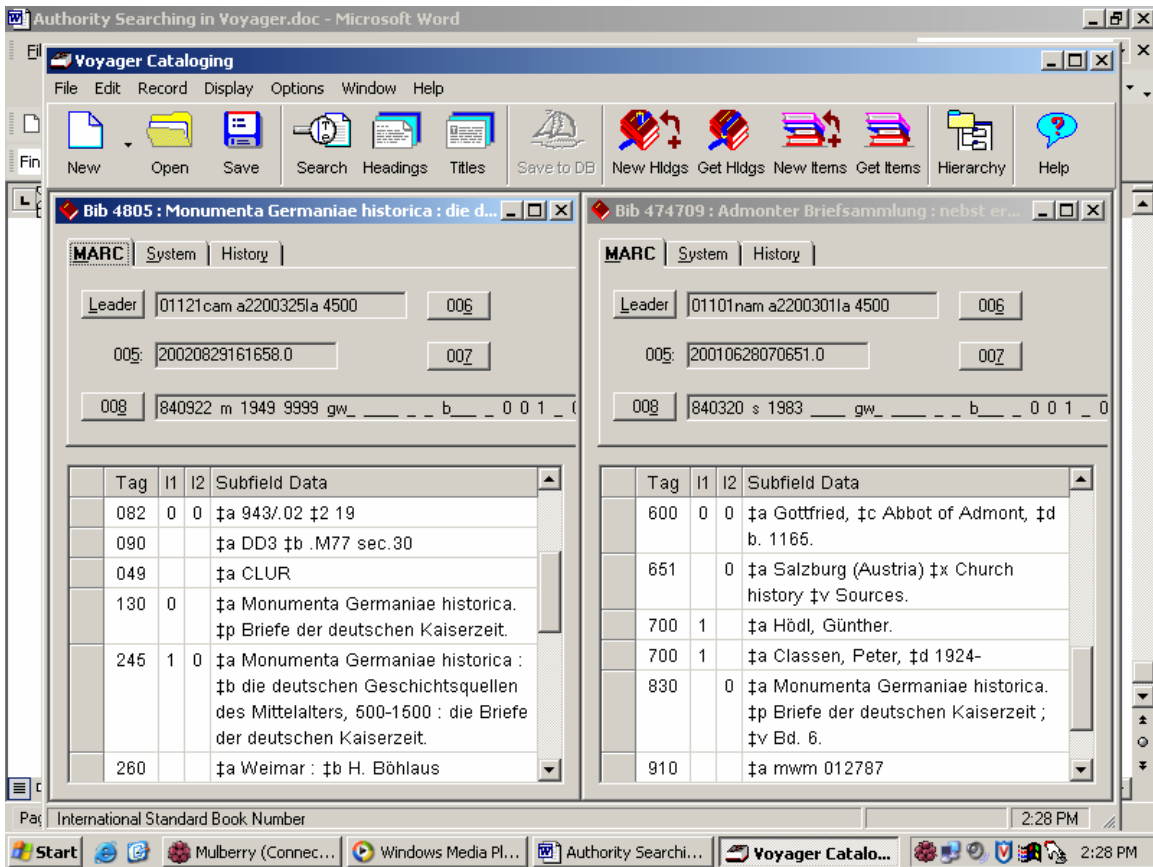


Image below:
