1. Suppressed record indicator
 - What it does: Suppressed records are highlighted in the Titles display
 - ❖ Example: Index selection, title search: Harry Potter (scroll down to see the highlighted title). Open up the bib record, click on "System" tab to see that record is suppressed from OPAC
 - To set
 - ❖ Options: Preferences: Colors/fonts

2. Item-to-bib navigation
 - What it does: From within the item record, can navigate to the linked bibliographic record. Especially useful for bound-withs
 - ❖ Example: Record, retrieve by barcode: a0001818871. Navigate to the bib. by clicking on the new icon in the toolbar: Get Bib. Retrieves all of the bound-with bibs, and opens them up

3. Default tab
 - What it does: Allows you to choose default tab in Search box (i.e., Keyword, Index Selection, or Builder)
 - To set:
 - ❖ NOTE: Options: Preferences: Workflow: Do NOT set "Retain last search"
 - ❖ Under each tab, "Default tab" button now shows. Grayed-out tab indicates the default search tab. To change the default, click on the highlighted "Default tab" on another search tab

4. Save settings
 - What it does: Under Keyword or Builder tab, allows you to set a default for the type of search you want to do
 - To set:
 - ❖ NOTE: Options: Preferences: Workflow: Do NOT set "Retain last search"
 - ❖ Under the Keyword or Builder tab, choose the appropriate index from the list provided, highlight it, and click on the new "Save settings" button. Search becomes the default under the tab specified

5. ISBN/ISSN validation

- What it does: supplies a validation error message when an invalid ISBN/ISSN is added to a record
- NO example. People who regularly do this type of work will notice if the error message appears. Will need to do appropriate editing, depending on the specific situation
